NEGLIGENT DISCHARGE SAFETY – THE INS AND OUTS OF WEAPON’S SAFETY

MUZZLE AWARENESS AT ALL TIMES: TREAT YOUR WEAPON AS IF IT IS ALWAYS LOADED, YOUR WEAPON AND AMMO DON’T CARE! TO HELP REMEMBER USE **THINK**:

Treat every weapon as if it were loaded.

Handle every weapon with care.

Identify the target before you fire.

Never point the muzzle at anything you don’t intend to shoot.

Keep the weapon on **safe** and your finger off the trigger until you intend to fire.



IAW Policy Letter #9 Command Safety

“ Ensure every Soldier assigned to the 10th Sustainment Brigade and subordinate units conduct a monthly weapons clearing validation. Soldiers will physically clear their individual weapons at an authorized clearing barrel; an NCO will inspect”.

Construction, maintenance, and location of clearing barrels can be found in Air Force Manual 31-229.
