



CHAPTER 5
SHELTER MAINTENANCE
Section I. MONTHLY INSPECTION

5-1. MONTHLY INSPECTION. Monthly maintenance inspections are designed to keep the System 50 Clamshelter in proper working order and catch any discrepancies before they become malfunctions. **Since many of the items on the monthly inspection list deal with safety issues, it is imperative that the monthly inspections are carried out regularly and completely.**
