

Army Safety Net

What is it?

Army Safety Net is an Army professional forum developed by the U.S. Army Combat Readiness/Safety Center, Fort Rucker, Ala., and hosted by the U.S. Army Combined Arms Center, Fort Leavenworth, Kan., for the Army safety community. Army professional programs are part of the Army's Knowledge Management System, which provides online professional forums that support all aspects of the Army mission and promote information sharing through facilitated discussions.

What has Army Safety done?

The objective of Army Safety Net is to provide a venue for members of the Army safety community and others across the Army's formations to share the latest ideas, innovations, procedures, lessons learned and best practices through networking. Army Safety Net is linked to more than 60 forums (e.g., Leader Net, Noncommissioned Officer Net, Warrant Officer Net) with more than 219,000 members. It is part of the web-based central repository of professional forums reviewed by organizations throughout the Army to identify best practices, upgrade and improve tactics, techniques and procedures, and provide training and doctrine updates.

What does Army Safety have planned for the future?

Army Safety Net is currently administered by the USACR/Safety Center Knowledge Management Office. It supports the Army's knowledge management initiatives pertaining to safety, primarily with a "bottom up" collaborative methodology. Approximately 2,850 members are currently registered with Army Safety Net, and marketing the tool among potential users will help the Army reduce accidents, maintain combat resources and achieve mission success.

Why is this important to the Army?

Historically, preventable accidents claim the lives of far too many Soldiers every year. Online tools like Army Safety Net allow individuals to obtain the information they need to mitigate risk 24/7.
